## INNOVATION IN TEACHING TECHNIQUES


#### **OBSERVATION**

• All the 75% students were talked to and found that students do not pay attention because of technical jargons and pronunciation problems.

• And a few needed counselling.

#### **Intervention -1**

- Students those who needed counselling were counselled on the importance of their career, studies and career.
- Impact of intervention -1:

- 30% of the 75% showed attention in the class,
- But at the same time the remaining could not follow the class and disturbed the class.







