
Data related to a total of 1096 families belonging to BPL was collected


BPL Family Requirements – Very few asked for monthly ration!


% OF YATHEEM IN DIFFERENT TALUKS

Almost 22% of the data collected are of yatheem, of which many have been abandoned by their husbands.


Almost 17% were in desperate state


