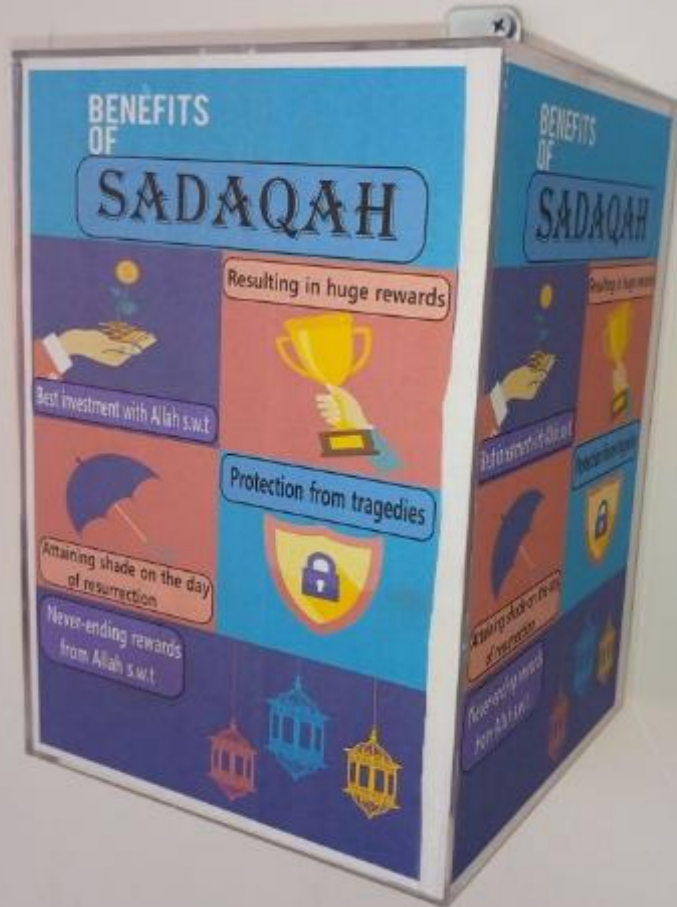

IBN AL-HAITHAM HALL

This Audio Visual Hall is named after a great Muslim scientist **Hasan Ibn Al-Haytham** (Latinised-**Alhazen**). He was an Arab mathematician, astronomer, and physicist of the Islamic Golden Age. Born in Basra, in c. 965, he made significant contributions to the principles of optics and visual perception in particular.

Ibn Al-Haytham was the first to explain that vision occurs when light bounces on an object and then is directed to one's eyes. Al-Haytham studied the process of sight, the structure of the eye, image formation in the eye, and the visual system.

Al-Haytham made significant contributions to optics, number theory, geometry, astronomy and natural philosophy. He was also an early proponent of the concept that a hypothesis must be proved by experiments based on confirmable procedures or mathematical evidence.

The year 2015 marked the 1000th anniversary since the appearance of the remarkable seven-volume treatise on optics **Kitab al-Manazir**, written by Ibn Al-Haytham. The year 2015 was declared as "The International Year of Light" by UNESCO and he is known as '**The Father of Optics**'.

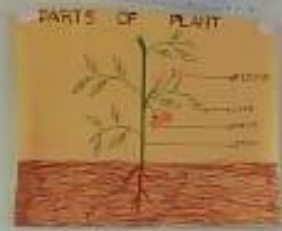

The form "a" is used before a word beginning with a consonant, or a vowel with a consonant sound.

eg: a man, a hat, a university, a European

The form "an" is used before words beginning with a vowel (a, e, i, o, u) or with words beginning with a silent "h".

eg: an apple, an island, an uncle, an hour

or individual letters spoken with a vowel sound.

eg: an L-plate, an MP, an SOS, an x-ray

a / an is the same for all genders:


eg: a man, a woman, an actor, an actress.

Using "an" is only based on the vowel sound, but not based on the vowel letters.

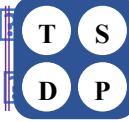
